


## 5<sup>th</sup> Session of the Meeting of Parties

A shuttle bus will bring you from and to the airport.

#### **Restaurants:**

Nice restaurants can be found all over the old city centre of Ljubljana, where the Hotel is located. Beside foreign specialties they offer numerous Slovenian delicacies and wines as well.

#### **Mobile phones:**

The mobile phone network in Ljubljana is well developed. But be careful with international calls. The rates are relatively high.

**Climate:**

Most of Slovenia has a continental climate. The average temperature is around 17-21°C in September. The Weather can be expected to be very sunny and warm. Nevertheless you should be prepared for rainy weather too.

**Field trip:**

No special equipment is needed for the field trip on Sunday 3 September.

**Security:**

Ljubljana is a very safe city. Like in all big cities there is a certain risk of pickpockets. You are advised to always bear the UN Certificate with you, which identifies you as a UN delegate. Please contact the Secretariat immediately in case of any problem.

**Currency:**

The currency is the Slovenian Tolar (SIT). 1 Euro corresponds to approximately 240 Tolar. A cash exchange counter is available inside the hotel. Banks and cash dispensers are located nearby the hotel.

**Insurance:**

You are yourself responsible for any kind of health and travel insurance.
